

Village Hall Charitable Trust Meeting held at 7pm Wed 6th March 2019

KEY MESSAGES.

- The Chairman reported, with regret, that all attempts to secure land within the Parish on which to build a new Village Hall of the size and scope originally envisaged had now been exhausted. Consequently the option to build a more modest structure on Church Green had been revisited and indicative plans for a smaller hall, with capacity for 75 people standing or for 50 people seated, with associated toilet and kitchen facilities, had been produced and were shown to the meeting. This proposal had received the unanimous support of the PCC, was unequivocally endorsed by Trustees and warmly received by the meeting.
- Church Green lies within the Churchyard and the PCC have agreed to now formally approach the Diocese for their consent to the proposal which is an essential pre-cursor to the VHCT submitting a pre-application for planning authority to East Hampshire District Council.
- The Trust approved the payment of an invoice for £500 plus VAT, £600 in total, from Davtee, the building consultancy who have been working with the VHCT on the Village Hall project.
